



Recruiting Classes 1971 – 1979

I started following BAMA recruiting in 1980 and I have enjoyed the past 20 years of watching classes arrive in T-Town always with high expectations and usually a high rating from the recruiting services. The ability to consistently bring in top classes is helped tremendously by BAMA's tradition. That tradition was taken to its lofty status by many years of winning and great players. Probably no period of time during those many years of success can match the 70's. I've always wanted to get copies of the 70's recruiting classes. Many great players chose the TIDE on signing day during that period. Championships were being won and Coach Bryant was at the top of the coaching echelon.

With BAMA a national power and highly visible on TV prospects were signed from all over the nation. After seeing the 70's lists I was shocked how many out-of-state prospects signed with BAMA. Yes, Coach Bryant got the "home boys" and many of "Dixie's best" each year, but you will find several names on the lists each year from across the nation. Also, without scholarship limits, Coach Bryant signed what he needed and many say "he took some he didn't need so others couldn't have them." The real core of BAMA's success though was the "home boys" BAMA kids from right here in the state.

I have put together the recruiting classes from that super decade of football success in the 70's. It covers the 1971 – 1979 classes. It simply is a list of the signees and a few facts about each that will help you get an idea of the individual's success in high school and then BAMA. I did not do any rating but give you enough facts to form a good opinion or rating of your own. It's been fun and I learned a lot about a period of time I was going through my school years and the only recruiting news I saw was the B'Post Herald top prospects list. The facts listed were from the university archives and the 2000 media guide.

I know many of you have wanted to see some old recruiting lists so I hope this helps and is some good information for your archives or brings back some great memories of a decade of BAMA's finest football and continued our tradition of great players and great teams. The 70's !!!!!

This class produced only 2 All-Star status players. CB Jeremiah Castille and C Steve Mott were 1-time All-Americans and 2-time SEC performers. Castille, Mott, and DL Randy Edwards went onto NFL careers.

I am very pleased with how this list of the 70's recruiting classes turned out. My goal was to simply provide a list of signees and enough information on each player that would enable anyone to form some kind of rating or opinion of the success or failure of the class. I believe from their high school achievements to college and a select few onto the NFL. You can get a pretty good read on their football career and the success of the overall class. I have learned a lot of new facts from this project. One item that really stands out is the consistent flow of players from BAMA to the NFL. This was without a doubt created from great coaching at BAMA.

The 70's was a great decade of football for BAMA fans. As you can see from the high school column, BAMA signed high school All-Americans from all over the nation and in large numbers. But we also saw numerous prospects signed with little fanfare go onto outstanding careers at BAMA. Coach Bryant and his assistants produced championships, great players, and outstanding young men. BAMA's famous winning tradition was taken to a higher level during the 70's with BAMA losing only 11 games from the 1971-1979 seasons. BAMA also was SEC Champions every year but 1976 during this period. Also, 3 National Championships were won.

I hope you enjoy these lists. I have heard many people, including myself, ask where the 70's recruiting classes could be found. Well, thanks to BAMAKEN, the University Archives and University Media Guide I have created such a list. My special thanks goes to BAMAKEN. I met him while I was at the Archives and he has provided some very good sources of information.

I have now created lists of all the recruiting classes from 1971 to present day. Many of you are on my mailing lists, which is presently about 250. Thanks to everyone for the nice notes and comments I receive thanking me for providing this information. Yes, it is a tremendous amount of work but, my LOVE for recruiting could only be satisfied with these type of projects. This is my way of contributing to TIDERINSIDER which provides me with the information I look for and spend time with fellow TIDE LOVERS.

Again, I now have available the 1971-1979 recruiting class list. The following lists are the ones I have rated with an incoming and outgoing grade for each player and class. These are the years I followed recruiting religiously. The 1980-1982 Bryant classes, 1983-1986 Perkins classes, 1987-1989 Curry classes and 1990-1996 Stallings classes. The 1996 class is the latest class to complete its eligibility. I don't send out a class until I do its outgoing rating. My objective with rating these lists is to compare the usual incoming euphoria with the actual outgoing results. It's been very interesting and very accurate.
